




FUNCTIONALISM

- Functionalism was concerned with how our mind works or **functions**




FUNCTIONALISM

- Functionalism refers to a school of thought within psychology that examines mental processes and how they relate to human behavior. Functionalism originated in the United States in the late nineteenth century




FUNCTIONALISM

- Functionalism values empirical thought and practical research, rather than the theoretical science of structuralism.




FUNCTIONALISM

- Psychologists **William James** and philosopher **John Dewey** represent famous advocates of functionalism. William James published "Principles of Psychology" in 1890.






FUNCTIONALISM

- William James borrowed the concept from Darwinism of nativism. He believed in nature as the cause of behaviors which influence the brain to cause different types of disorders if damaged. The weakness of functionalism influenced the rise of behaviorism in early 20th century.




FUNCTIONALISM
