BAR CODE

- ▶ Bar Code is a series of black and white bars and spaces that represents a series of characters and symbols. Bar codes are read by sweeping a small spot of light across the printed bar code symbols.
- ▶ Information is stored from left to right.
- ▶ Letters, numbers, characters and symbols are designed to store information in the form easily read and printed by machine.



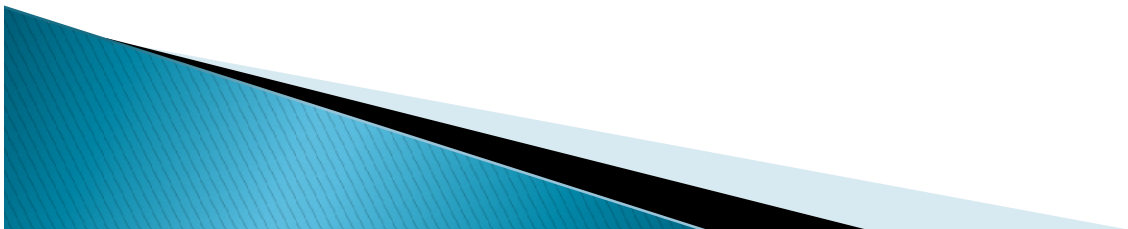
Why Bar codes are used?

- ▶ Bar codes are accurate
- ▶ They eliminate manual data entry errors.
- ▶ Bar codes speed data entry. A Bar code can be scanned in a fraction of the time it takes to enter the information manually.
- ▶ Bar codes can be produced easily and cheaply.
- ▶ Can be printed on most computer printers for the cost of ink and printer.



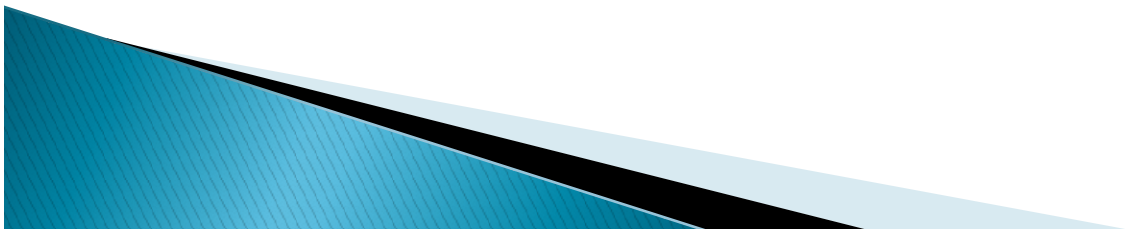
▶ Applications of Bar code technology
