CCTV [Closed Circuit Television]

Meaning-

- CCTV system provide surveillance capability used in the protection of people, assets and systems.
- A CCTV system links a camera to a video monitor using a direct transmission system.



- This differs from broadcast television where the signal is transmitted over the air and viewed with a television.
- Closed circuit TV is a self- contained surveillance system comprising cameras, records and displays for monitoring activities n a store or company.



- CCTV is a TV system in which signals are not publicly distributed but are publically monitored primarily for surveillance and security purposes.
- CCTV relies on strategic placements of cameras, and observation of the camera's input on monitors somewhere.
- CCTV refers to electronic monitoring systems which make use of video cameras, connected by means of a closed (or non broad cast) circuit to capture, collect, record and for relay visual information about the event
 -state of a given space over time.

- How do CCTV system work?
- Once an image has been picked by the camera, it is taken to the monitor and then records on video tape or DVR.
- The ability of the camera to zoom in and out is determined by the type of lens, it has. It is used in building and homes for security purposes.
