

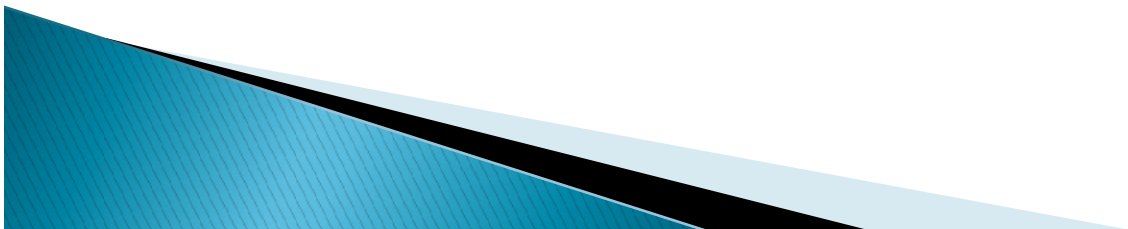

▶ PRINCIPLES OF FACET SEQUENCE

- ▶ Dr. S.R. Ranganathan gave the principles of arranging more than one isolate ideas of any facet.

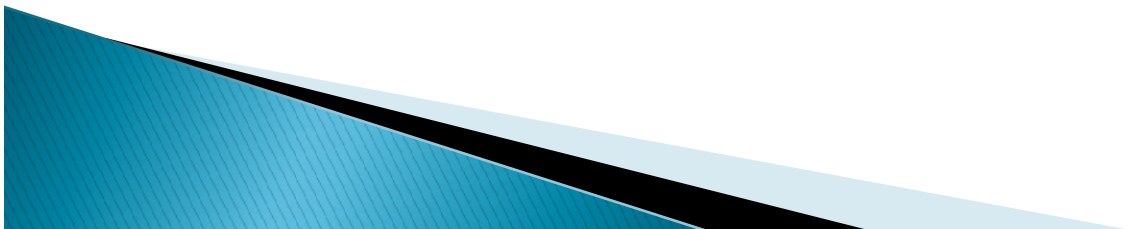


▶ Wall Picture Principle

- ▶ If 2 facets A and B of a subject are such that the concept behind B will not operate unless the concept behind A is conceded.

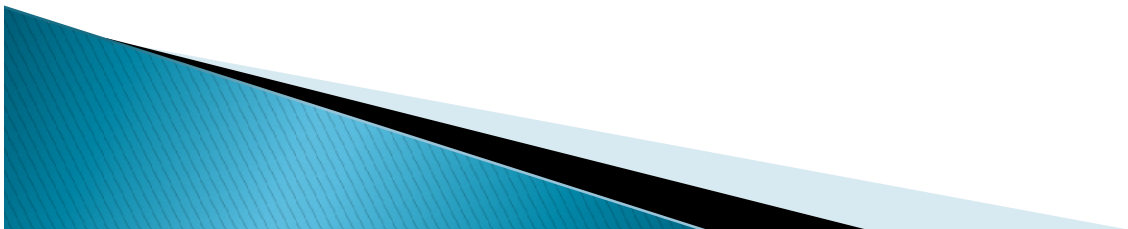
▶ Whole Organ Principle

- ▶ If in a subject, facet B is an organ of facet A then A should precede B.



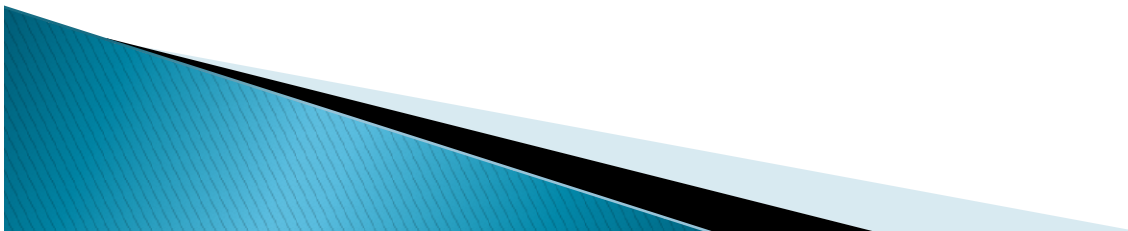
▶ Cow– Calf Principle

- ▶ If a facet A and another facet B belonging to the same subject cannot be separated though they are distinct from each other, A and B should be kept together.



▶ Act and–Action–Actor– Tool Principle

- ▶ If A is a commodity out of the raw material forming B and by the transformation forming C, then three facets should be arranged in the sequence A, B, C.
