Concept Note

The main purpose of the first session is to guide the students for locating and searching women's studies online resources and databases effectively, and to provide links of major online databases. In addition, we will also demonstrate the OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) of CWDS library which is a comprehensive collection on women's studies and always useful as a starting point for searching documents on the subject in general. We will also demonstrate the Knowledge Gateway which is a virtual knowledge center on Women's Studies for the South Asia Region.

Over the last few years, managing references manually is becoming difficult. But there are various software packages to manage references and citations. These are known as Reference Management Software (RMS) or citation management software, or bibliographic management software. In the second session, we will give an introduction to all available RMS and will explain how to use Zotero.

What's Zotero? It's free citation management software that can organize research for multiple projects with multiple formats (books, articles, webpages, and video). It integrates with Microsoft Office and Open Office, and can create an alphabetized bibliography in your choice of style,
