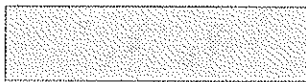

1. A candidate is required to pass separately in theory and practical examination.
2. At each of the previous and the final year examination in a subject a candidate must obtain for a pass (i) at least 36% of the aggregate marks in all the papers prescribed at the examination & (ii) at least 36% marks in practical wherever prescribed at the examination; provided that if a candidate fails to secure 25% marks in each individual paper of theory at any of the examination and also in the dissertation wherever prescribed he/she shall be deemed to have failed at the examination notwithstanding his/her having obtained the minimum percentage of marks required the aggregate for that examination.
3. Division will be awarded at the end of the final examination on the combined marks obtained at the previous & the final examinations taken together. No division will be awarded at the previous examination.

4. (a) A candidate who has failed at M.Com/M.A./M.Sc. (Prev.) examination for want of aggregate minimum but has passed in at least 50% of the practical papers separately prescribed for the examination obtaining 36% marks in each paper prescribed in accordance with the rules given below shall be eligible to re-appear in the failing papers of previous along with the final examination.
(b) A candidate who has failed at the M.Com/M.A./M.Sc. (Final) examination for want of aggregate minimum but has passed in at least 50% of the theory and practical separately obtaining 36% marks in each paper prescribed for the examination in accordance with the rules given below shall be exempted from re appearing in a subsequent year in the papers in which he/she has passed.
 - i) For reckoning 50% of the papers at the previous examination practical will be included and one practical will be counted as one paper.
 - ii) Where the number of paper prescribed at the previous examination is an odd number it shall be increased by one for the purpose of reckoning 50% of the papers.
 - iii) Where a candidate fails for want of securing minimum aggregate marks but secures 36% marks in at least 50% of the papers, he/she will be exempted from re-appearing in those papers which he/she has secured 36% marks.
 - iv) Where the candidate secures the requisite minimum percentage in the aggregate of all the papers but fails for want of the requisite minimum percentage of marks prescribed for each individual paper, he/she shall be exempted from re-appearing in such paper(s) in which he/she has secured at least 25% marks.
5. (a) A candidate who does not pass even in 50% of the papers prescribed for M.Com/M.A./M.Sc. (Prev.) examination in accordance with the above rules shall not be eligible for admission to the M.Com/M.A./M.Sc. (Final) class. He will be required to re-appear at the previous examination in all the prescribed papers
(b) A candidate who does not pass even in 50% of the papers prescribed for M.Com/M.A./M.Sc. (Final) examination in accordance with the above rules shall be required to re-appear at the same in a subsequent year in all prescribed papers.
6. Application for re-evaluation must be submitted with in 10 days from the date of declaration of the result.
7. In case of any mistake being detected during the preparation of marksheet or brought to the notice afterwards, the University will be fully empowered to correct the same.
8. Star (*) shown against the paper/subject denote failure in that paper/subject and is a due paper for promoted candidates.
9. All legal matters will be subject to Udaipur Jurisdiction only.
10. The answer book scripts of the candidate will be disposed off immediately after 90 days from the date of the issue of the mark sheets.
11. Carefully check entries in your mark sheet. No grievance related to results and marks shall be entertained after 90 days from the issue of mark sheet.
