Add On / Audit Course

Each student will have to complete two add on courses of 2 credit each in four semesters as compulsory courses.

- a) Language and Communication Skills in English**
- b) Personality Development & Well-Being**

1. Core Courses (Basic / Fundamental Courses) ARE 4 credits each.(CC for Semester I & II)
2. ELECTIVES (Advanced Courses) should be within 4 credits each (EC for Semester III & IV).
3. Each student for each paper will submit Assignment/ Project work/ Seminar Presentation which will be mandatory for Core Courses & Electives and shall be assigned 1 credit each
4. ADD On / Foundation Courses:
Each student will have to complete two add on courses of 2 credit each in four semesters as compulsory courses

a). Language & Communication Skills in English

b). Practical Ethics, Human Rights & Environmental Awareness

c). Personality Development & Well-Being

d). Community Work

e). Art Appreciation & Creative Writing
