

PAPER IX(A) (5730 A) DISSERTATION

For Dissertation any Post-Graduate teacher in Rural Sociology (including the head of the Department of Rural Sociology) will act as Supervisor. However, a Supervisor will not supervise to more than five students. The dissertation will be based on collection of first hand data and their sociological analysis by the students. The following conditions are laid down with regard to the form of presenting the dissertation.

1. Only those students will be allowed to offer this paper who secure at least 55% marks in Previous Examination (M.A. Rural Sociology).
2. Use paper of 8 ^{1/2} X11" size for submitting the report.
3. Typing : Use double space typing.
4. The text: text of the field report shall not exceed more than 100 pages.
5. The report should be well bound.

The students shall submit three typed copies of their dissertation to the Head of the Deptt. by 20th February. He shall get two copies of the same forwarded to the University by march 1st. The title page and the first page of the report contains:

- (i) Title of Dissertation
- (ii) Name of the Candidate
- (iii) Roll No. (if assigned by that time)
- (iv) Enrolment No.
- (v) Name of the College and Centre

The dissertation shall bear the following certificate from the Head of the Department and dissertation supervisors.

To the best of our Knowledge we certify that the facts reported by the candidate in this report have been collected first hand under our guidance & supervision and that other sources wherever used have been duly acknowledged.

One period per week students shall be provided for the dissertation.

EXAMINATION and MARKS:

The dissertation will be evaluated by a committee consisting of the following.

One internal and one external member. Internal member will be appointed by the head of the institution.

Distribution of the marks will be as under :

Dissertation and viva-voce (50+50) = 100.
