1. Dr. Satinder Ahuja

Dr. Satinder Ahuja earned his Ph. D. degree from University of Sciences, Philadelphia. He worked at Novartis Corporation for 25 years in different leading positions and simultaneously served as Adjunct Professor at several Universities. In the last few decades, he has helped in solving problem of Arsenic contamination in Bangladesh, India and US. As a founder of Ahuja Academy of Water Quality at UNC, Wilmington, he encourages researches on various water quality issues.

2. Prof. R.K. Sharma

Prof. R. K. Sharma is presently Professor and Coordinator of Green Chemistry Network Centre, established at Department of Chemistry, University of Delhi. After obtaining his Ph.D. in 1986 from University of Delhi, Prof. Sharma worked as JSPS Post Doctoral Fellow at Kumamoto University and University of Tokyo, Japan. He had received several awards like 2010 INSA-JSPS Award to visit Japan, 2010 UGC-TEC award to visit Mauritius, 2002 INSA-JSPS Award, 1999 World Green Award, 1998 Research Grant Award by Royal Society of Chemistry London, 1998 Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) Post Doctoral Award, 1995 Indo-German Award and 1995 UGC National Research Scientist Award.

3. Prof. K.R. Desai

Prof. K.R. Desai is working as Director, Department of Chemistry, Uka Tarsadia University, Surat. Earlier he worked as Professor and Head, Department of Chemistry, South Gujarat University, Surat. He has many awards to his credit like Lifetime Achievement Award by JERAD – 2011, Emeritus Professor Award by UGC-New Delhi-2008, Scientist of the Year Award by National Science and Environmental Academy, New Delhi – 2002 etc.
